what to expect

A home inspection is a visual assessment of a house's physical structure and mechanical systems, including the roof, ceilings, walls, floors, windows and doors. The inspector will check that major appliances are functional, scrutinize the heating and airconditioning system, examine the plumbing and electrical systems and may even poke around in the attic and basement.

The goal of a home inspection is to uncover issues with the home itself.

An inspection is not a pass-fail exam. No fixes are mandatory after a home inspection, though it may uncover issues that prompt further negotiations.
